**WHEREAS**, the Board is an independent administrative board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that is responsible for the administration of the probation and parole laws of this Commonwealth, 61 Pa.C.S. § 6111(a);



**WHEREAS**, the Board is authorized to appoint and employ such numbers and character of officers, agents, clerks, stenographers and employees as are necessary to carry out its duties, 61 Pa.C.S. § 6118(a);

**WHEREAS**, senior level appointment employees perform a wide variety of tasks and duties for the benefit of the Board, as a whole;

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to establish conditions of employment that reflect the responsibilities and duties of senior level appointment employees of the Board, as a whole;

**NOW THEREFORE**, effective immediately, decisions in matters of hiring, rating, retention, compensation, and discipline involving senior level appointment employees shall be made by a majority of the Board.
