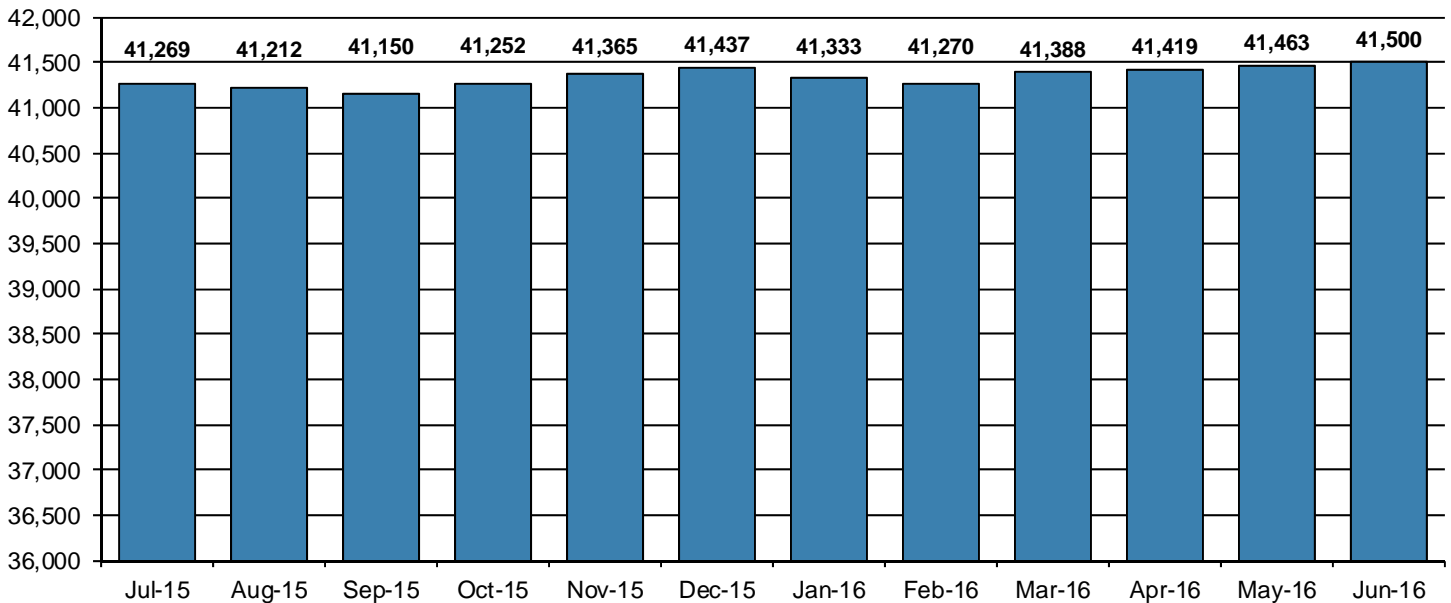

**Population - Retrospective Year View**

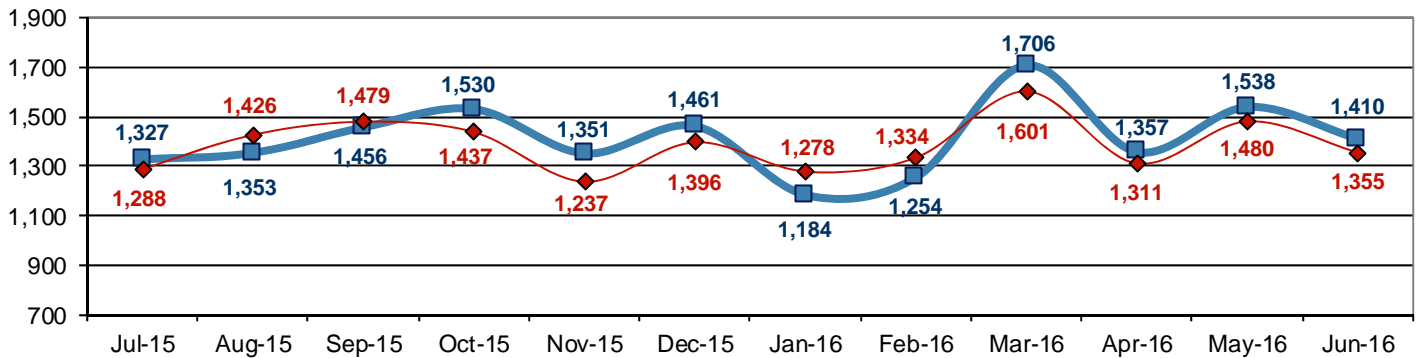

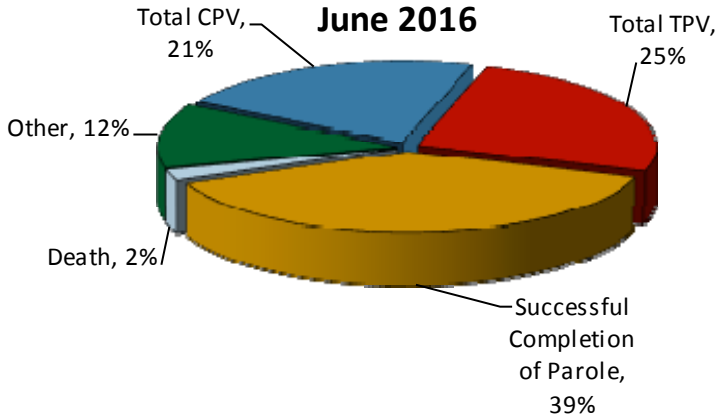
**Population Additions & Deletions-Retrospective Year View**

■ Additions    ◆ Deletions



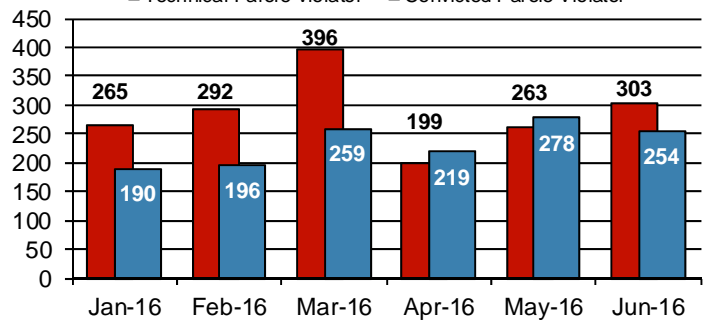

■ Technical Parole Violator    ■ Convicted Parole Violator

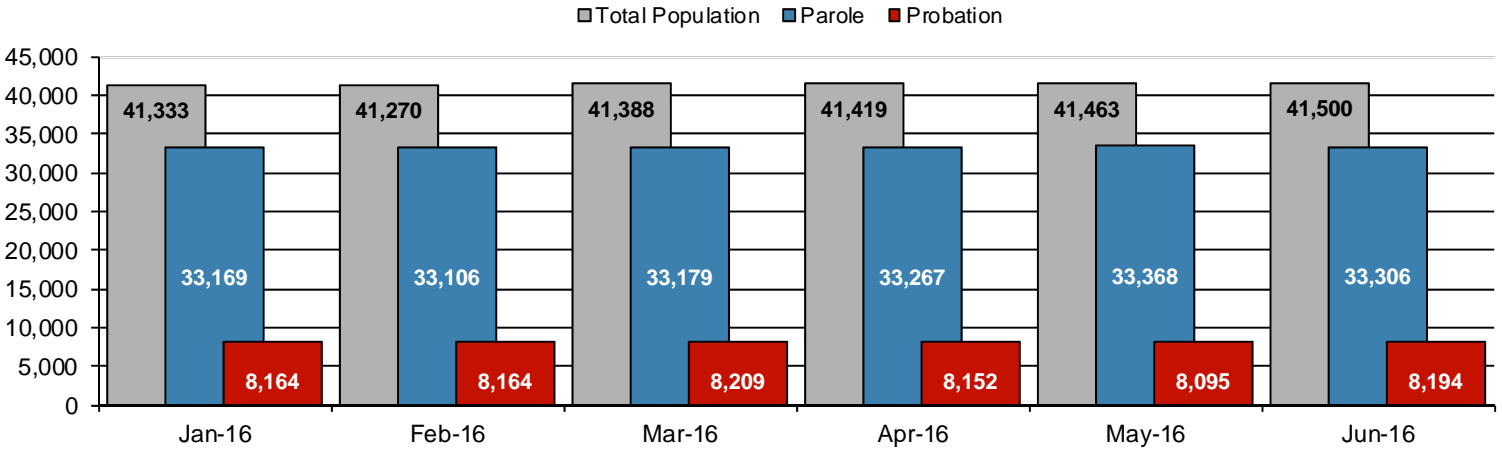

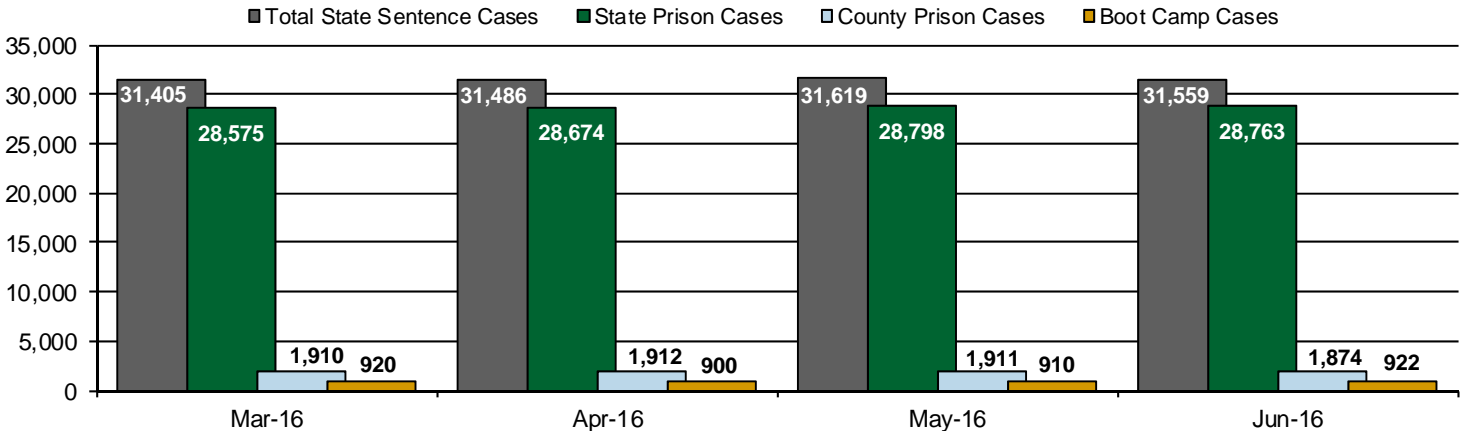

**Parole and Probation Supervised Populations**



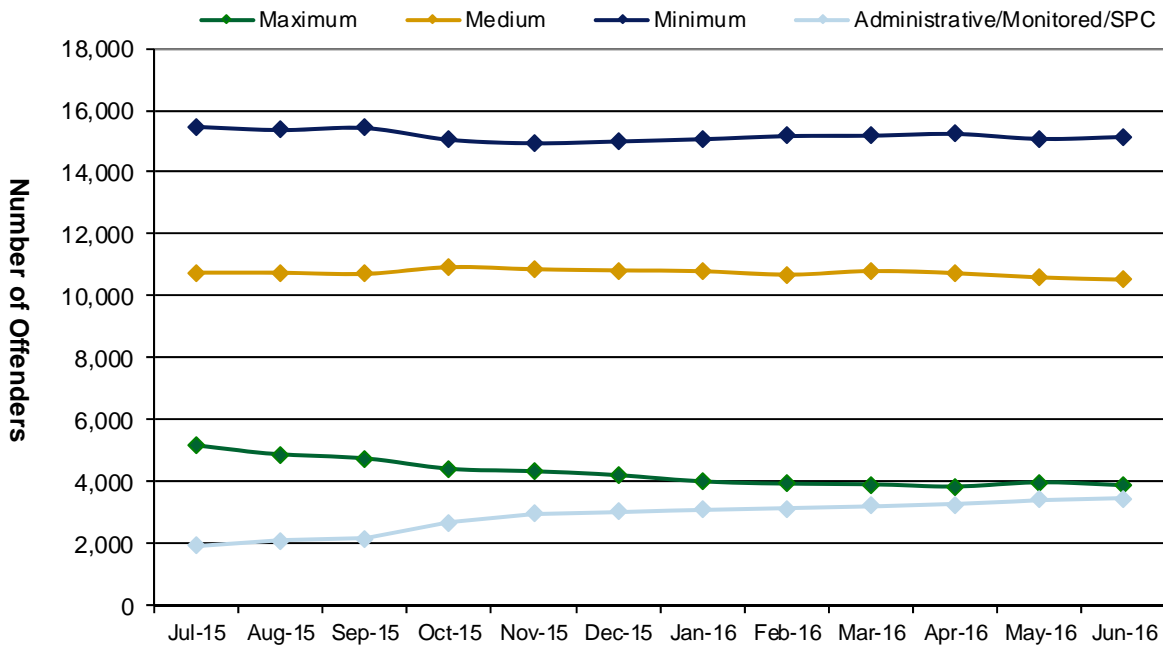
**Supervised State Sentence Cases**



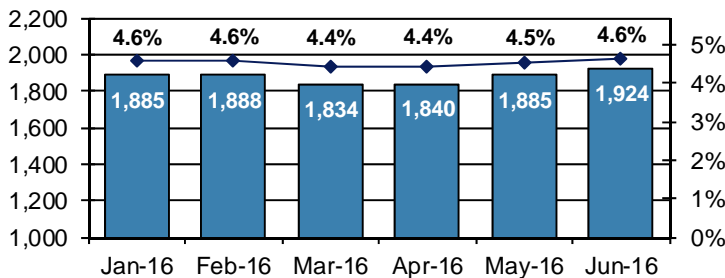

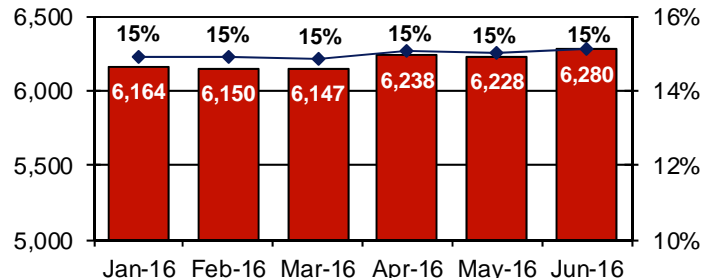
**PBPP Active Cases By Supervision Level**

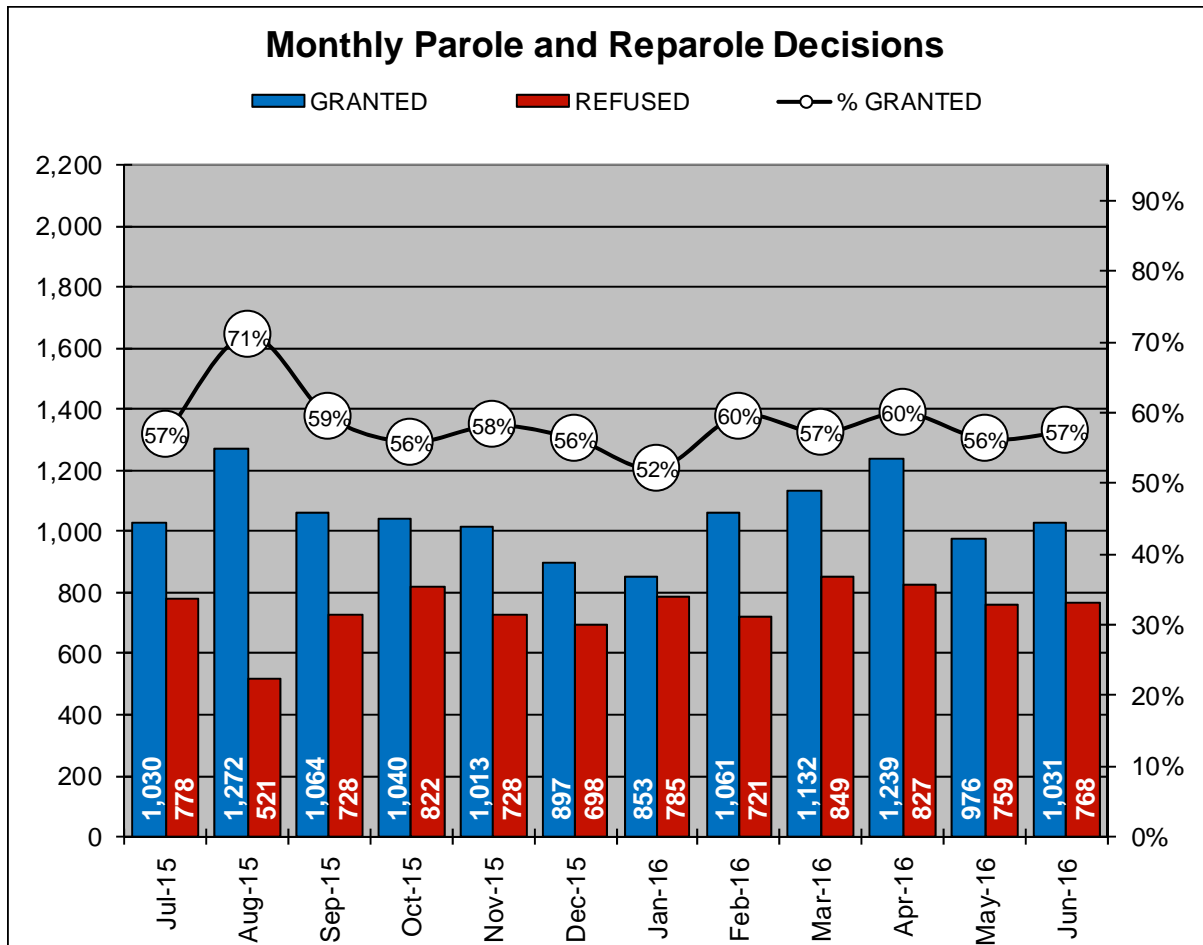

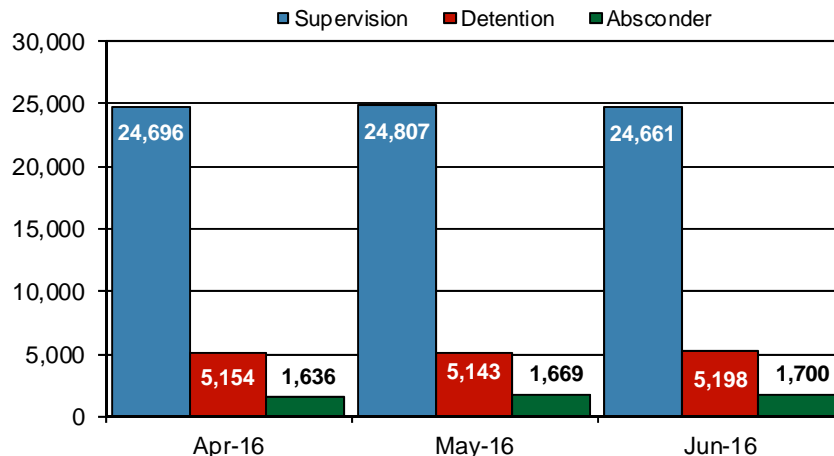
