


**Population - Retrospective Year View**






**Population Additions & Deletions-Retrospective Year View**

**State Sentence Parole Revocations\***






**Parole and Probation Supervised Populations**

□ Total Population   □ Parole   ■ Probation




**Supervised State Sentence Cases**

□ Total State Sentence Cases   ■ State Prison Cases   ■ County Prison Cases   ■ Boot Camp Cases





**Number of Detainees and % of Population**






**Number Employed and Employment Rate\***









### State Sentence Additions




- The Eastern Region's previous six-month average number of state sentence additions is 280. June 2007 amount is 43% more than the previous six-month average.

### Number of Absconders and Detainees




- In June 2007, the 779 absconders represented a decrease of 1% below the previous six-month average of 790, and the 2,486 detainees represented a decrease of 5% below the previous six-month average of 2,606.

- The 162 Eastern Region state sentence parole violators in June 2007 consisted of 45 convicted parole violators (38%) and 117 technical parole violators (72%).






- The Central Region's previous six-month average number of state sentence additions is 314. June 2007 amount is 7% greater than the previous six-month average.

- The 150 Central Region state sentence parole violators in June 2007 consisted of 59 convicted parole violators (39%) and 91 technical parole violators (61%).







- In June 2007, the Western Region accounted for 23% of the statewide total of 962 state sentence additions.

### Number Employed and Employment Rate\*




- The June 2007 employment rate was two percentage points higher than the previous six-month average of 70%.
- The number of employed parolees in June 2007 was 4% more than the previous six-month average of 3,783.

### Number of Absconders and Detainees



- In June 2007, the number of absconders was equal to the previous six-month average of 324, and the 1,608 detainees represented a decrease of 6% below the previous six-month average of 1,703.
- The Western Region accounted for 21% of the 1,538 statewide absconders and 27% of the 5,863 statewide detainees in June 2007.

### State Sentence Parole Revocations



- The Western Region accounted for 31% of the 450 statewide state sentence parole violator revocation field case closures in June 2007.
- The 138 Western Region state sentence parole violators in June 2007 consisted of 52 convicted parole violators (38%) and 86 technical parole violators (62%).
