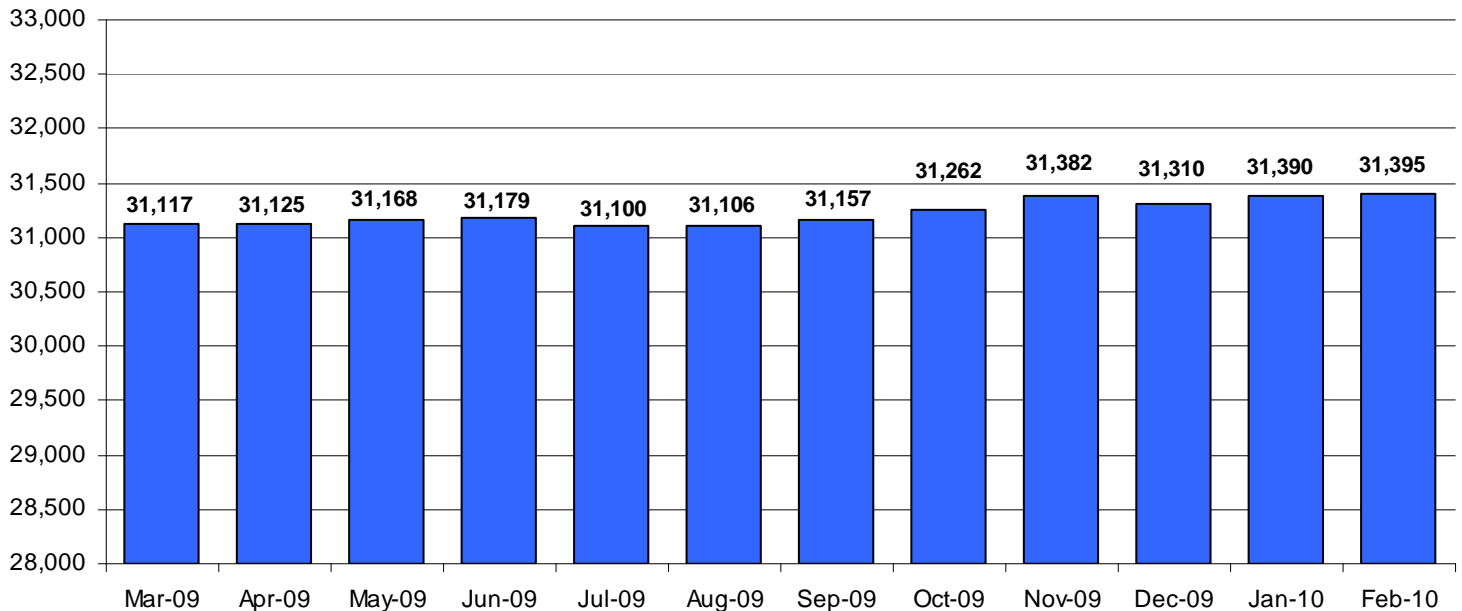

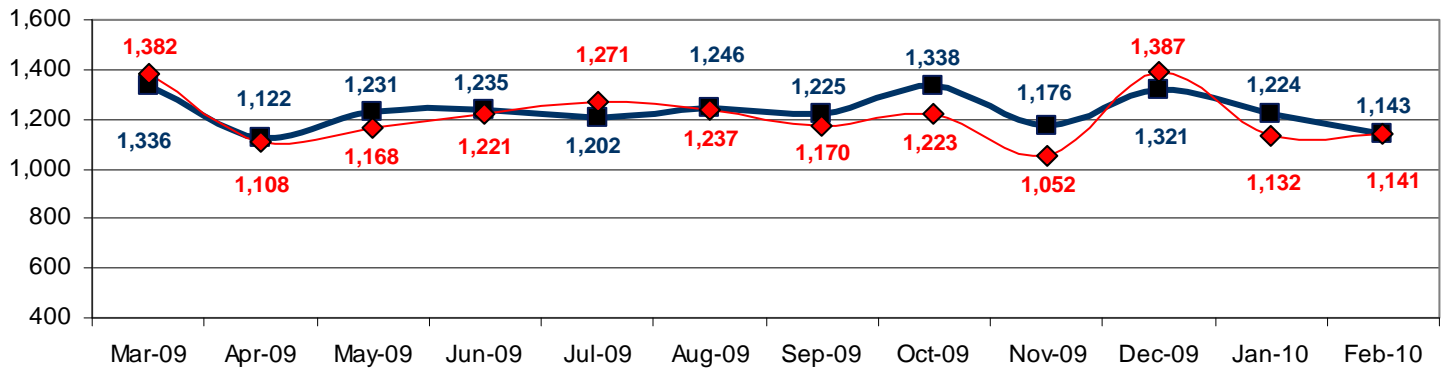

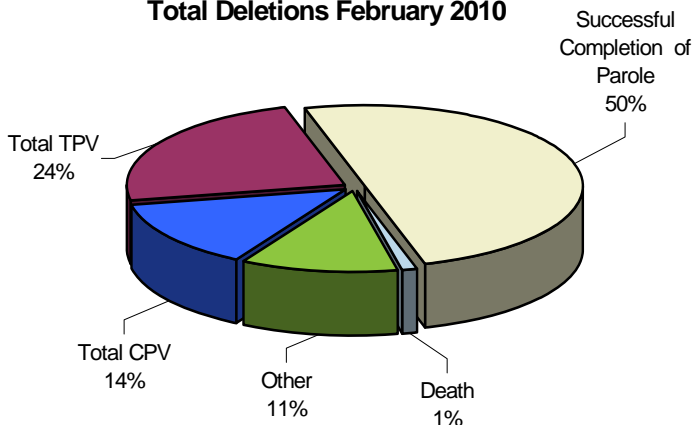

**Population Additions & Deletions-Retrospective Year View**

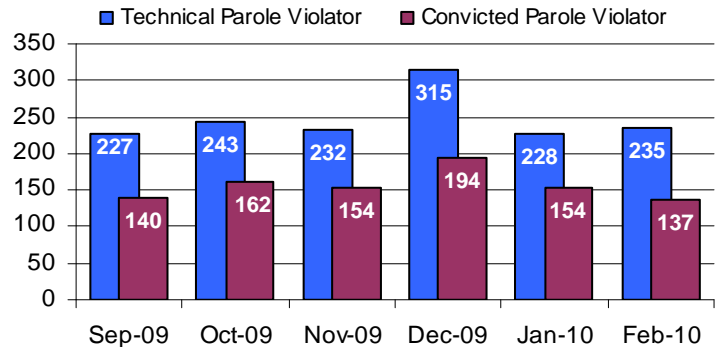
■ ADDITIONS ◆ DELETIONS

**State Sentence Parole Revocations\***

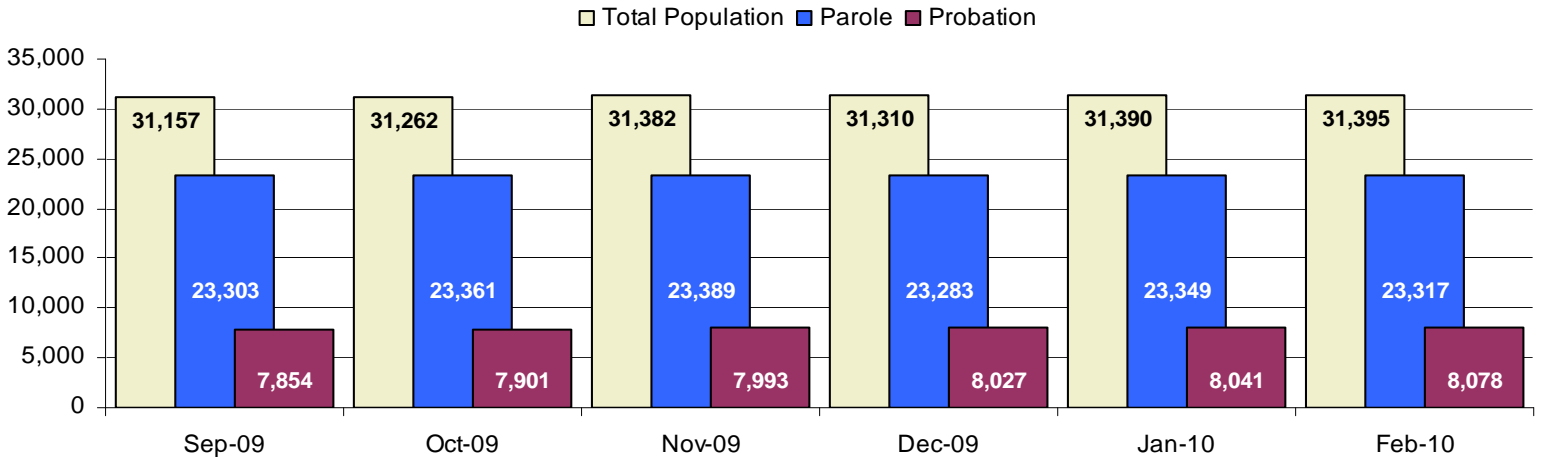

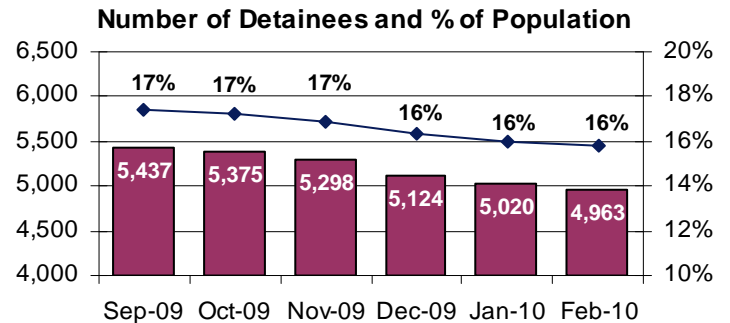
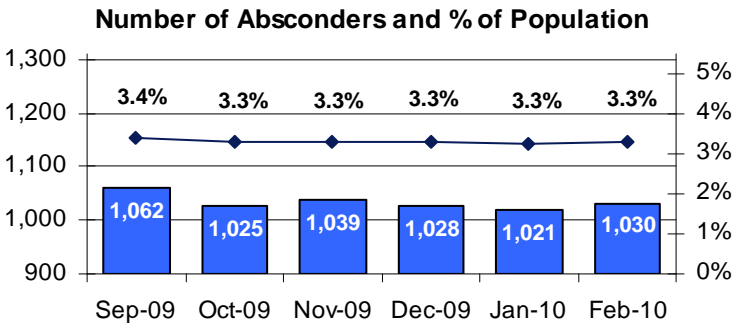
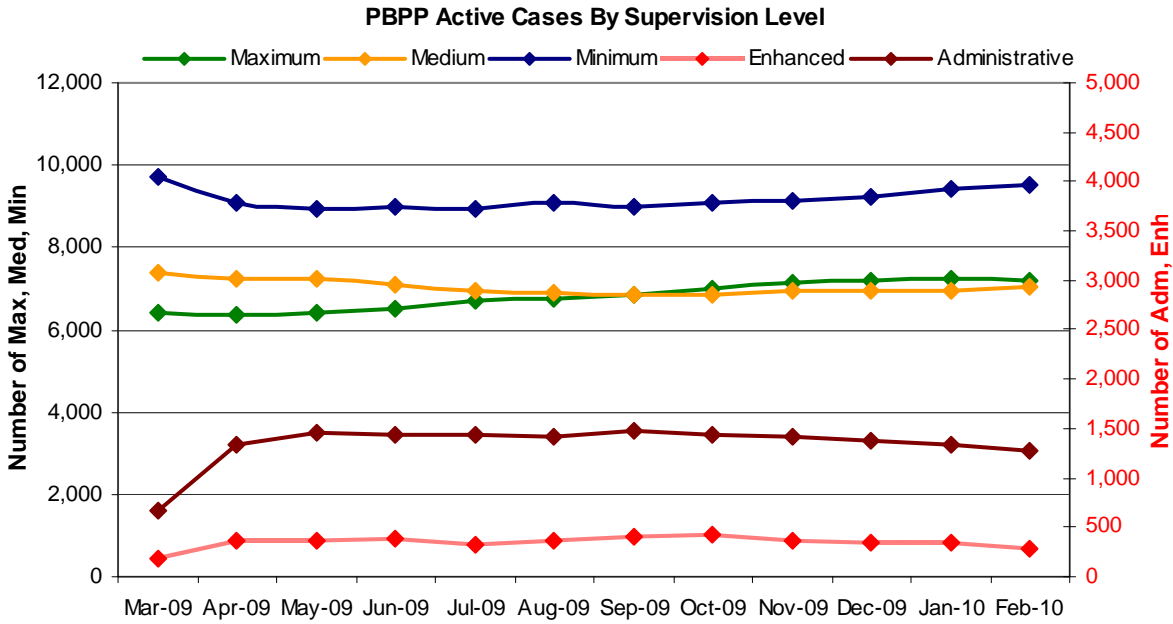


**Supervised State Sentence Cases**
