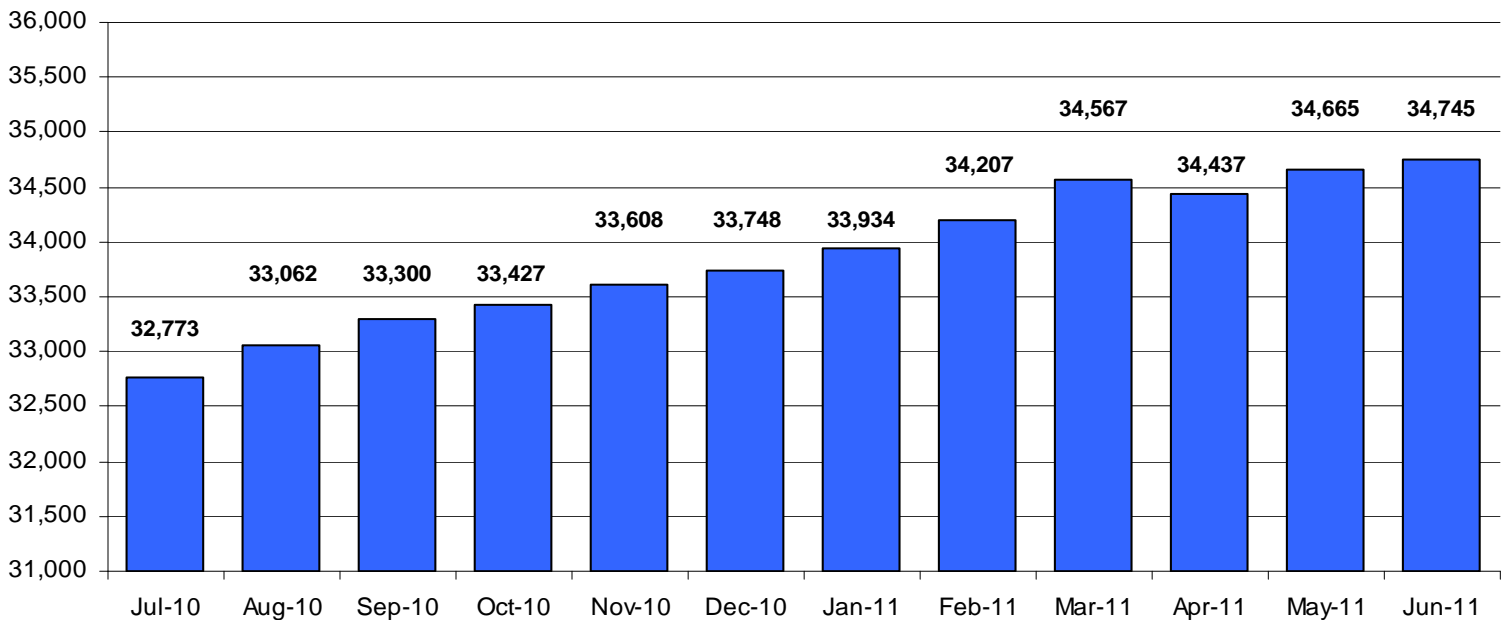

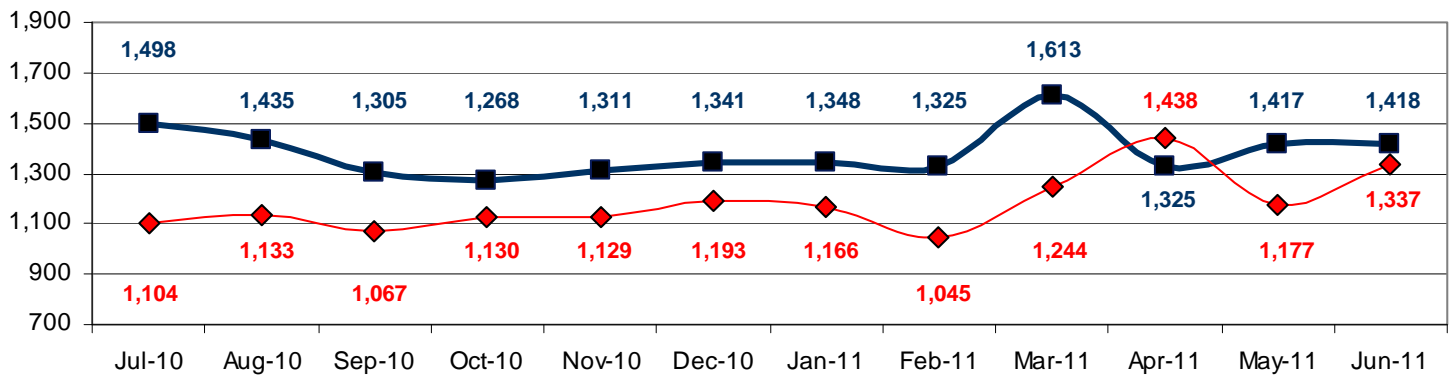

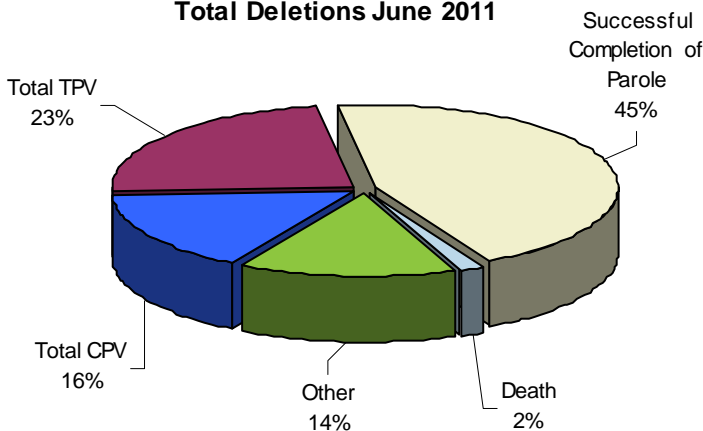

**Population Additions & Deletions-Retrospective Year View**

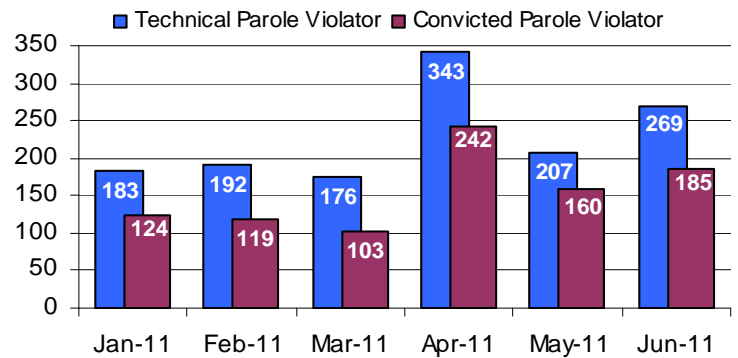
■ ADDITIONS ◆ DELETIONS

**State Sentence Parole Revocations\***



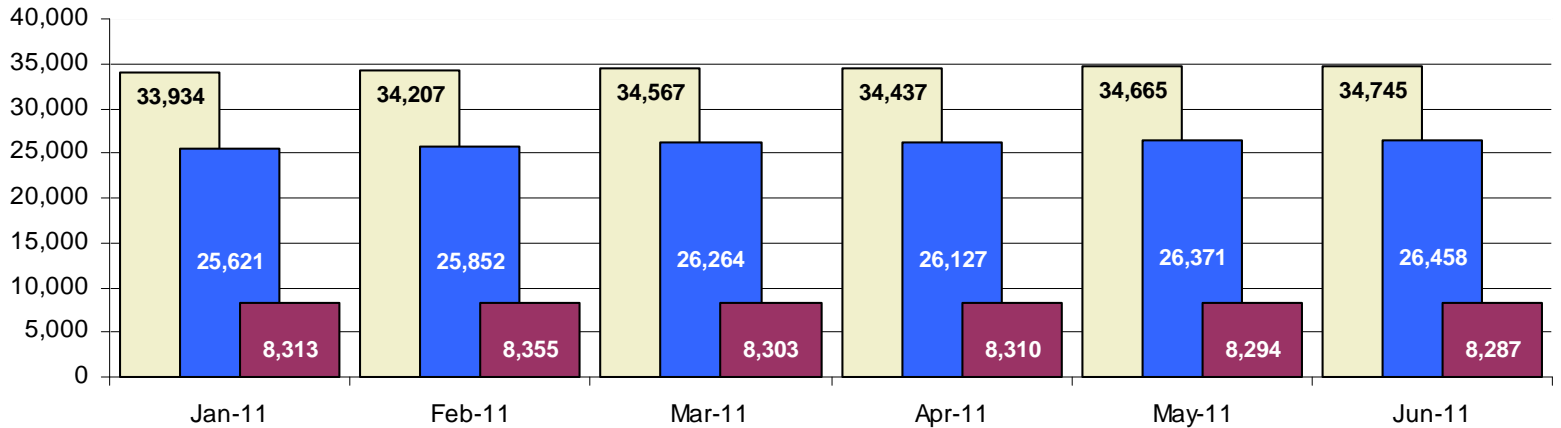

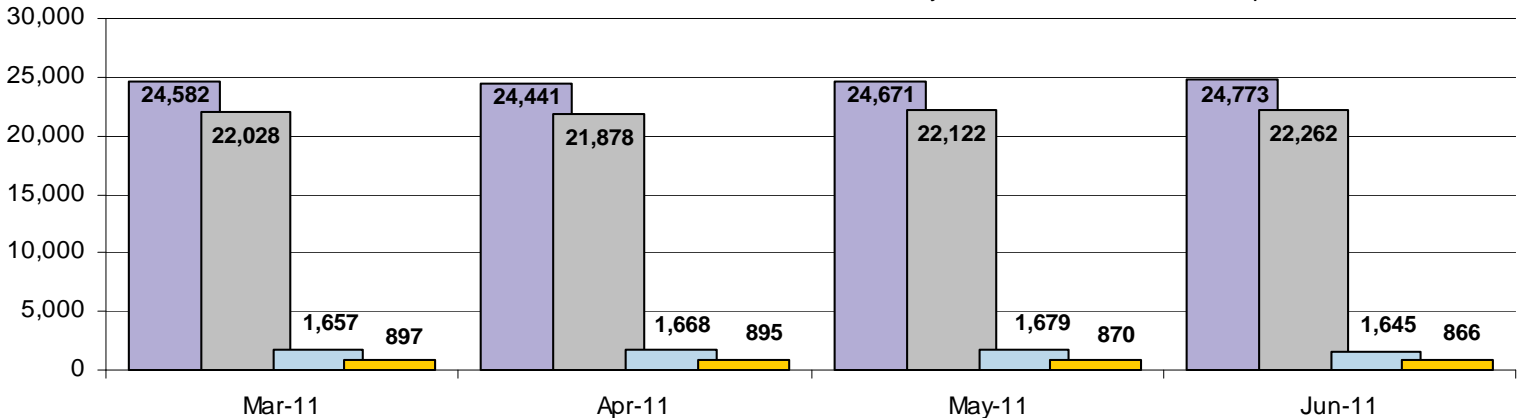
**Parole and Probation Supervised Populations**
