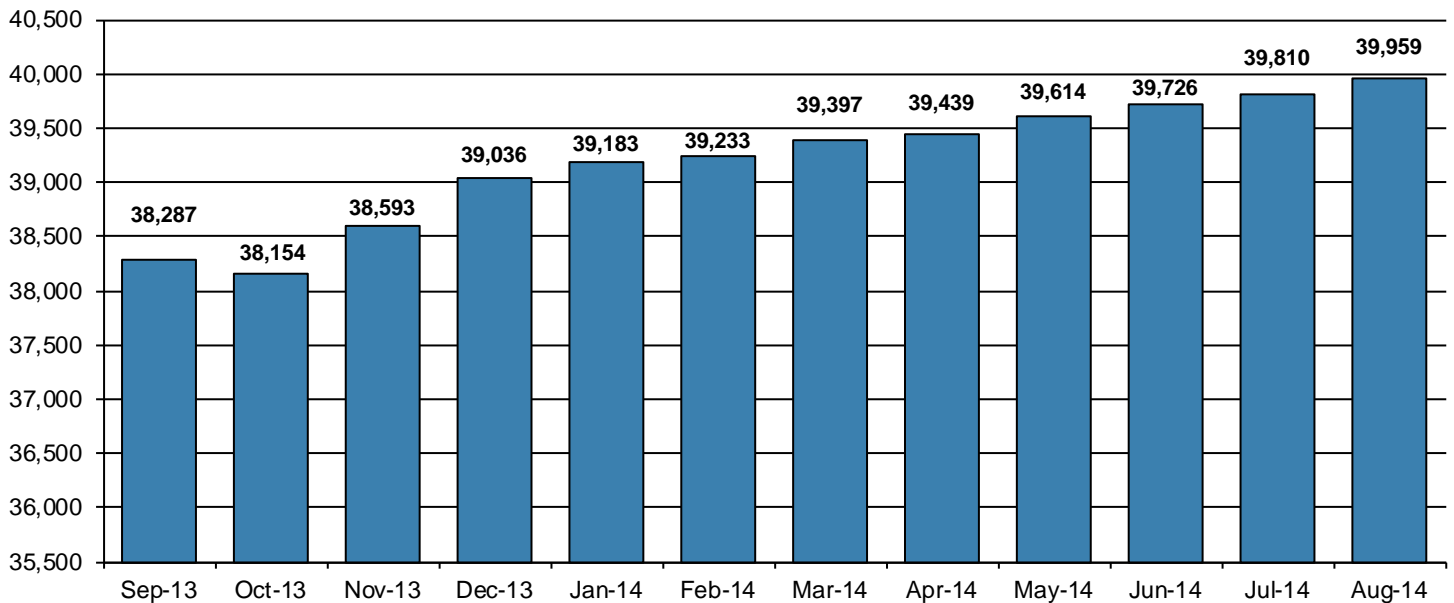

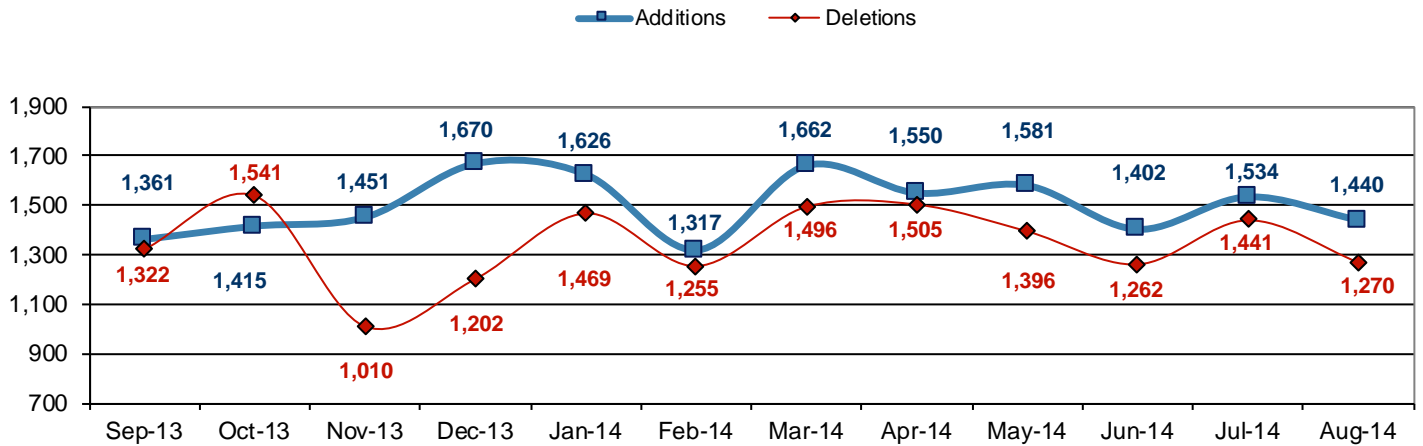
Population - Retrospective Year View



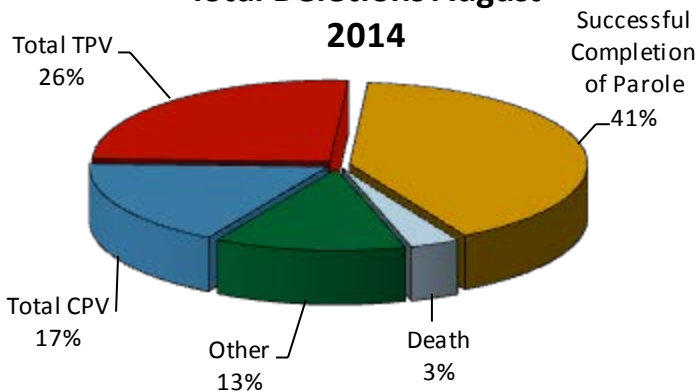

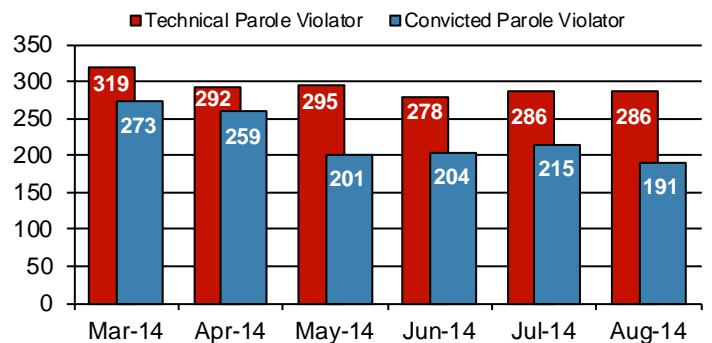
Population Additions & Deletions-Retrospective Year View

State Sentence Parole Revocations*

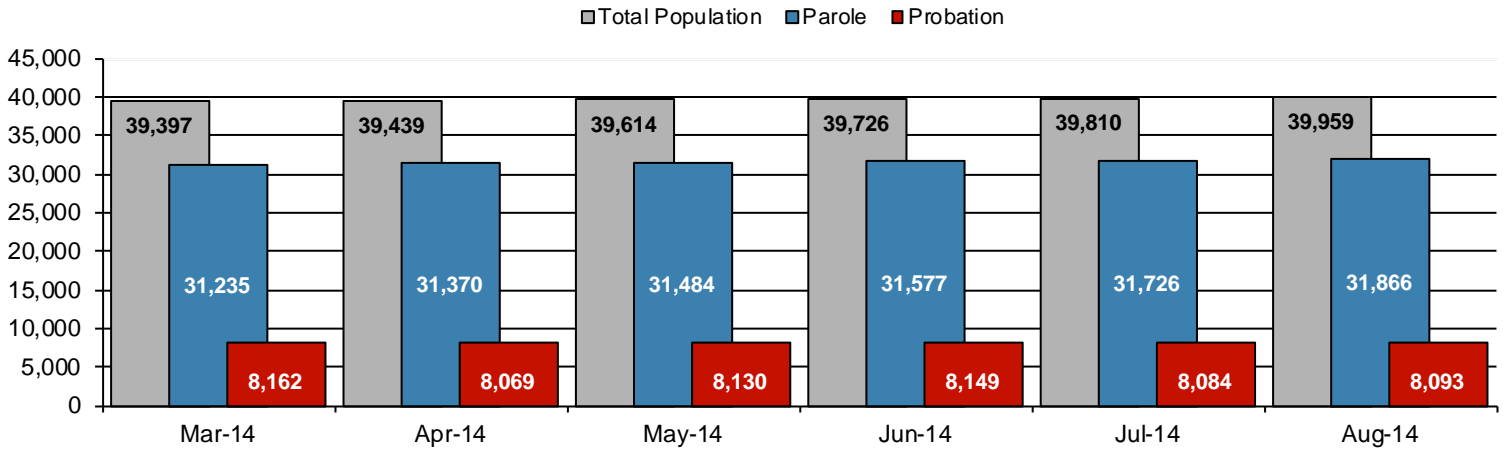

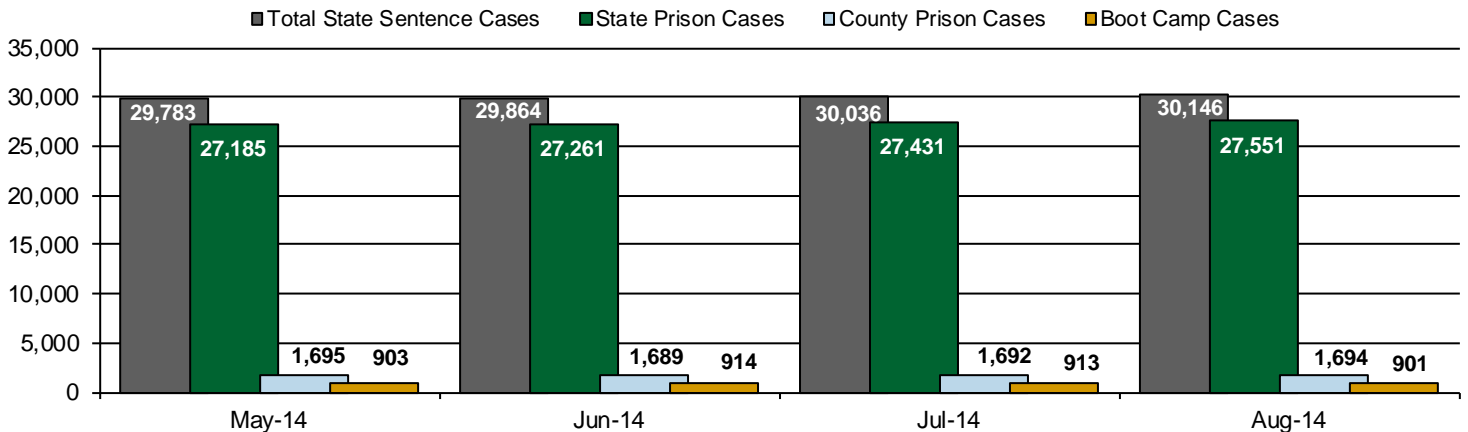
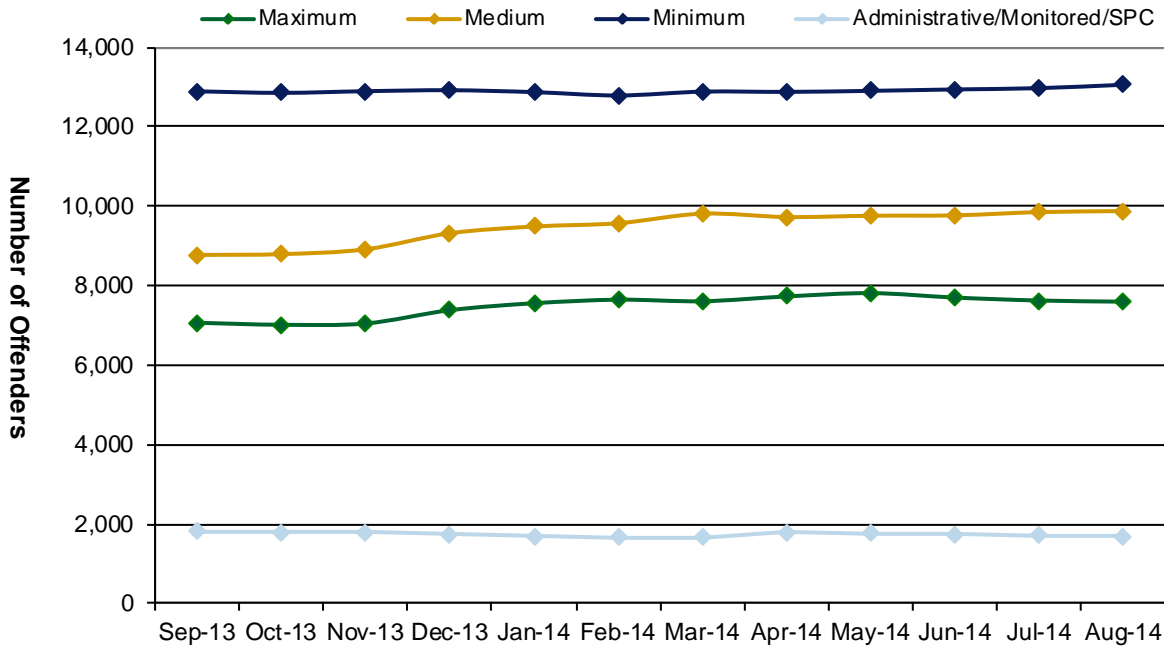


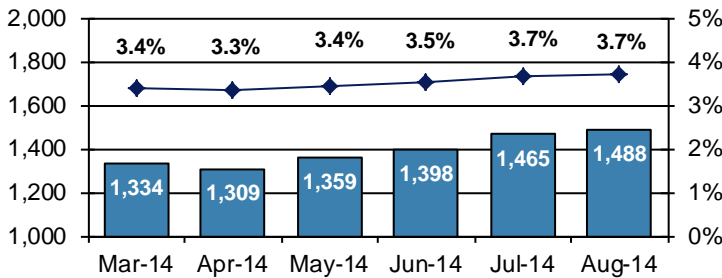

Number of Detainees and % of Population

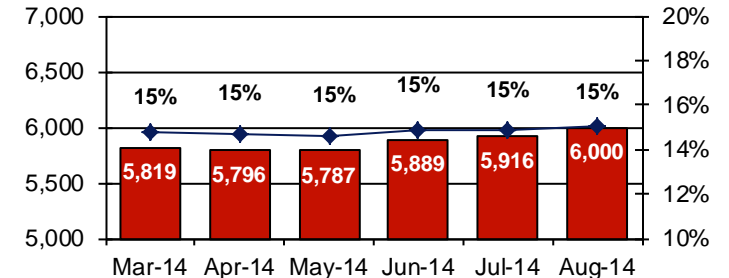

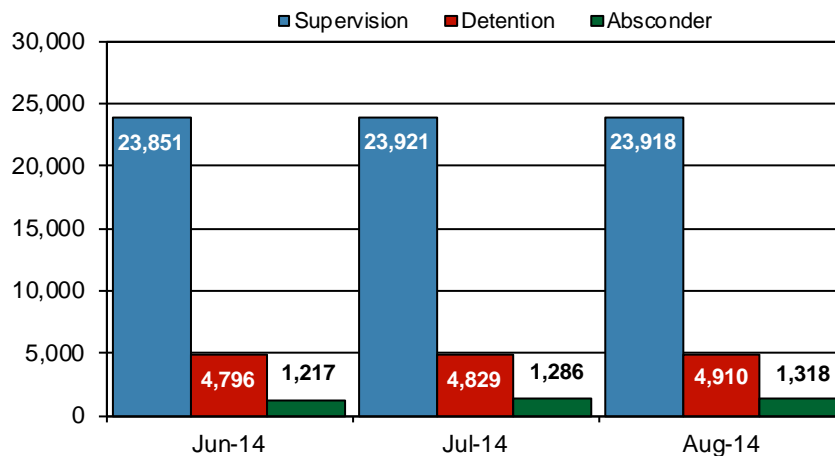
