

Total Agent Workload - Retrospective Year View











PBPP Population Breakdown By Place of Incarceration/Jurisdiction – January 2007







- In January 2007, the Eastern Region accounted for 37% of the statewide total of 879 state sentence additions.

Number Employed and Employment Rate*



- The January 2007 employment rate was one percentage point less than the previous six-month average of 62%.
- The number of employed parolees in January 2007 was 2% less than the previous six-month average of 4,049.

Number of Absconders and Detainees



- In January 2007, the 798 absconders represented a decrease of 4% below the previous six-month average of 829, and the 2,667 detainees represented an increase of 2% above the previous six-month average of 2,604.
- The Eastern Region accounted for 50% of the 1,585 statewide absconders and 42% of the 6,390 statewide detainees in January 2007.



- The Eastern Region accounted for 34% of the 360 statewide state sentence parole violator revocation field case closures in January 2007.
- The 121 Eastern Region state sentence parole violators in January 2007 consisted of 30 convicted parole violators (25%) and 91 technical parole violators (75%).

• The Central Region population was 9,452 or 32% of the 29,454 January 2007 statewide population.



- In January 2007, the Central Region accounted for 39% of the statewide total of 879 state sentence additions.


Number Employed and Employment Rate*

- The Central Region accounted for 29% of the 1,585 statewide absconders and 31% of the 6,390 statewide detainees in January 2007.








