

### Total Agent Workload - Retrospective Year View







### **Total Deletions February 2007**











- In February 2007, the Eastern Region accounted for 34% of the statewide total of 728 state sentence additions.




- The February 2007 employment rate was two percentage points less than the previous six-month average of 62%.

- The Eastern Region accounted for 51% of the 1,573 statewide absconders and 42% of the 6,346 statewide detainees in February 2007.




- The Eastern Region accounted for 37% of the 412 statewide state sentence parole violator revocation field case closures in February 2007.



- In February 2007, the Central Region accounted for 39% of the statewide total of 728 state sentence additions.


# **Number Employed and Employment Rate\***

- The Central Region accounted for 28% of the 1,573 statewide absconders and 31% of the 6,346 statewide detainees in February 2007.




- The Central Region accounted for 44% of the 412 statewide state sentence parole violator revocation field case closures in February 2006.




- The Western Region's previous six-month average number of state sentence additions is 211. February 2007 amount is 8% less than the previous six-month average.

### Number Employed and Employment Rate\*




- The February 2007 employment rate was three percentage points less than the previous six-month average of 72%.
